LOCAL AGENCIES. Prohibits a governing authority from entering certain agreements without specific approval by ordinance of all affected governing authorities. (gov sig)

AN ACT

2 To enact R.S. 33:9683, relative to political subdivisions of the state; to prohibit a local 3 governing authority from engaging in certain acts; to provide for exceptions; and to provide for related matters. 4 5 Be it enacted by the Legislature of Louisiana: Section 1. R.S. 33:9683 is hereby enacted to read as follows: 6 7 §9683. Prohibited activities 8 A. Notwithstanding any provisions of law to the contrary, no governing 9 authority of any political subdivision of the state which operates, controls, owns, 10 or maintains property or facilities that provide services in multiple parishes 11 shall enter into any agreement to assign, transfer and deliver, sell, lease, contract for management of, or any other transaction or agreement involving 12 13 the property or facilities without the specific approval by ordinance of all the 14 governing authorities where the property or facilities are located, operate in, or 15 provide service. B. The provisions of Subsection A of this Section shall supersede and 16 preempt any home rule charter provision inconsistent with or in conflict with 17

the provisions of Subsection A of this Section.

C. The provisions of this Section shall not apply to the governing authority of any public port or public airport or any flood control or coastal restoration agency, authority, or board.

Section 2. This Act shall become effective upon signature by the governor or, if not signed by the governor, upon expiration of the time for bills to become law without signature by the governor, as provided by Article III, Section 18 of the Constitution of Louisiana. If

vetoed by the governor and subsequently approved by the legislature, this Act shall become

effective on the day following such approval.

<u>Proposed law</u> prohibits the governing authority of any political subdivision of the state which operates, controls, owns, or maintains property or facilities that provide services in multiple parishes from entering into any agreement to assign, transfer and deliver, sell, lease, contract for management of, or any other transaction or agreement involving the property or facilities without the specific approval by ordinance of all the governing authorities where the property or facilities are located, operate, or provide service.

<u>Proposed law</u> provides that it shall supercede and preempt any home rule charter provision not consistent with or in conflict with proposed law.

<u>Proposed law</u> exempts public port authorities, public airport authorities, flood control or coastal restoration agency, authority, or board.

Effective upon signature of the governor or lapse of time for gubernatorial action.
