SENATE CONCURRENT RESOLUTION NO. 11

BY SENATOR MORRISH

LEGIS POWERS/FUNCTIONS. Designates October as Eczema Awareness Month in Louisiana.

1	A CONCURRENT RESOLUTION
2	To designate October as Eczema Awareness Month in Louisiana.
3	WHEREAS, eczema is a very common condition that causes the skin to be red, itchy,
4	dry, and scaly, and more than thirty million Americans have some form of it; and
5	WHEREAS, at its most severe, eczema can cause serious health problems,
6	profoundly affect quality of life, and interfere with normal, everyday activities; and
7	WHEREAS, different types of eczema include atopic dermatitis, contact dermatitis,
8	dyshidrotic eczema, hand eczema, neurodermatitis, nummular eczema, and stasis dermatitis;
9	and
10	WHEREAS, all types of eczema cause itching and redness, but some may also cause
11	the skin to blister, weep, or peel; and
12	WHEREAS, the most common type, which can also be severe and long-lasting, is
13	atopic dermatitis; and
14	WHEREAS, eczema generally appears in the first six months to five years of a
15	child's life and babies usually develop it on their face, especially the cheeks and chin, but it
16	can appear anywhere on the body and symptoms may be different from one child to the next;
17	and
18	WHEREAS, the pain and constant itch of eczema can distress children and disturb

1	their sleep, interfere with school, cause low self-esteem, make them feel self-conscious about
2	their appearance, and avoid social situations; and
3	WHEREAS, each individual's eczema can be triggered by unique environmental
4	factors, which may appear when the body reacts to environmental elements that would
5	normally be harmless; and
6	WHEREAS, Eczema Awareness Month serves as an opportunity to focus attention
7	on eczema and its symptoms, triggers, and treatments.
8	THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Legislature of Louisiana does hereby
9	designate October as Eczema Awareness Month.
