SCHOOLS/TRANSPORTATION: Requires identification lettering on all school buses used to transport students to public schools in Orleans Parish

1 AN ACT

2 To enact R.S. 17:161.1, relative to school buses in Orleans Parish; to require all school buses
3 used to transport students to public schools in Orleans Parish to contain lettering
4 identifying the name of the school or schools; and to provide for related matters.

5 Notice of intention to introduce this Act has been published
6 as provided by Article III, Section 13 of the Constitution of
7 Louisiana.

8 Be it enacted by the Legislature of Louisiana:

9 Section 1. R.S. 17:161.1 is hereby enacted to read as follows:

10 §161.1. School buses in Orleans Parish; lettering requirements

11 Each school bus used to transport students to public schools in Orleans Parish
12 shall contain lettering identifying the name of the school or schools for which it
13 transports students. The lettering shall be black and in block form. The lettering shall
14 be placed on both sides of the bus as high as possible to provide maximum visibility.

Proposed law requires each school bus used to transport students to public schools in Orleans Parish to contain lettering identifying the name of the school or schools.
