Abstract: Authorizes a fee on fuel used by commercial marine vessels

<u>Proposed law</u> defines "commercial marine vessel" as meaning any ship, tanker, tug, towboat, barge, or similar vessel for which the dredging and deepening of waterways would benefit its transportation or movement.

<u>Proposed law</u> establishes a fee of eight cents per gallon on dyed diesel fuel, as defined in <u>present law</u>, used by commercial marine vessels.

Proposed law requires that the fee be deposited into the Dredging and Deepening Fund.

<u>Proposed law</u> specifies that the revenue generated by the fee must be used in accordance with proposed law.

<u>Proposed law</u> requires the Dept. of Revenue to promulgate rules and regulations regarding the imposition, collection, payment, and remittance of the fee.

<u>Proposed law</u> makes the effectiveness of <u>proposed law</u> contingent on the enactment of Senate Bill No. 148 of the 2017 Regular Session.

Proposed law sunsets proposed law on July 1, 2019.
