2	contrary, the judge may utilize the monies in the judicial expense fund to pay all or
3	any part of the cost of establishing or maintaining a law library for the court, for the
4	renovation, improvement, or purchasing of existing structures or construction of new
5	structures to be used for any purposes incidental to, or related to, the proper
6	administration or function of the court or the office of the judge, or for buying or
7	maintaining any type of equipment, supplies, or other items consistent with or
8	germane to the efficient operation of the court. For purposes of this Paragraph, the
9	judge may utilize monies in the judicial expense fund for capital outlay expenses
10	associated with the renovation or construction of the courthouse or office of the
11	judge including but not limited to design, demolition, construction, materials,
12	supplies, equipment, and labor.
13	(3) In general, the judicial expense fund is established and may be used for
14	any purposes connected with, incidental to or related to the proper administration or
15	function of the said court or the office of the judge thereof, and is in addition to any

19	Section 2. The provisions of this Act shall be given prospective and retroactive

21	Section 3. This Act shall become effective upon signature by the governor or, if not
22	signed by the governor, upon expiration of the time for bills to become law without signature
23	by the governor, as provided by Article III, Section 18 of the Constitution of Louisiana. If
24	vetoed by the governor and subsequently approved by the legislature, this Act shall become

**Abstract:** Authorizes money in the 35<sup>th</sup> Judicial Expense Fund to be used for personnel health insurance premiums, certification fees, continuing education fees, and capital expenditures.

<u>Present law</u> allows the use of money in the 35<sup>th</sup> Judicial Expense Fund to pay salaries of court reporters, law clerks, secretaries, and other necessary research personnel, to establish or maintain a law library, and to purchase supplies and equipment, or for any other purpose related to the efficient operation of the court.

<u>Proposed law</u> retains <u>present law</u> and specifically authorizes the use of money in the 35<sup>th</sup> Judicial Expense Fund to pay personnel health insurance premiums, certification fees, or continuing education fees and for capital outlay expenditures including renovations of existing structures, construction of new structures, and any purpose related to the proper administrative function of the court or office of the judge.

Provides that the provisions of <u>proposed law</u> are to be applied retroactively as well as prospectively.

Effective upon signature of governor or lapse of time for gubernatorial action.
