9 On page 1, delete lines 10 through 17 and delete pages 2 and 3 in their entirety and on page 10 4, delete lines 1 through 4 and insert the following:

- "Section 1. The introductory paragraph of R.S. 15:574.4(D)(1) and 574.4(D)(1)(a) 11 12 and (2) are hereby amended and reenacted to read as follows:
- §574.4. Parole; eligibility; juvenile offenders 13

15 D.(1) Regardless of the date of conviction and sentence and notwithstanding 16 Notwithstanding any provision of law to the contrary, any person serving a sentence of life imprisonment who was under the age of eighteen years at the time of the 17 18 commission of the offense, except for a person serving a life sentence for a conviction of first degree murder (R.S. 14:30) or second degree murder (R.S. 19 20 14:30.1, shall be eligible for parole consideration pursuant to the provisions of this 21 Subsection if all of the following conditions have been met:

22 (a) The offender has served thirty twenty-five years of the sentence imposed. 23

(2) For each offender eligible for parole consideration pursuant to the provisions of 24 25 this Subsection, the board committee on parole shall meet in a three-member panel, and each member of the panel shall be provided with and shall consider a written 26 evaluation of the offender by a person who has expertise in adolescent brain 27 development and behavior and any other relevant evidence pertaining to the 28 29 offender. *
