PUBLIC BUILDINGS/GROUNDS: Names a building at Lincoln Elementary School in Monroe in honor of Roy Neal Shelling, Sr.

1 AN ACT

2 To enact R.S. 17:85.1, relative to Monroe City Schools; to name the building used as an
3 auditorium and gymnasium at Lincoln Elementary School; and to provide for related
4 matters.

5 Notice of intention to introduce this Act has been published
6 as provided by Article III, Section 13 of the Constitution of
7 Louisiana.

8 Be it enacted by the Legislature of Louisiana:

9 Section 1. R.S. 17:85.1 is hereby enacted to read as follows:

10 §85.1. Naming of building at Lincoln Elementary School in Monroe

11 The building used as an auditorium and gymnasium at Lincoln Elementary
12 School, which is under the jurisdiction of the Monroe City School Board, is
13 designated and shall be known hereafter as the "Roy Neal Shelling, Sr.
14 Auditorium/Gym".
