2	To commend Edna Karr High School on its many accomplishments.
3	WHEREAS, Edna Karr Junior High School opened on February 3, 1964, and quickly
4	established itself as the premier public secondary school on the Westbank of Orleans Parish;

6	WHEREAS, excelling in academics, athletics, and an unprecedented range of
7	extracurricular activities, Edna Karr soon proved that its motto "Second to None" was more
8	than mere rhetoric; and
9	WHEREAS, "Second to None" became a challenge to each group of incoming
10	students to uphold and further Edna Karr's burgeoning reputation for excellence, and they

12	WHEREAS, recognizing the increasing need for a dedicated, college preparatory
13	public high school on the Westbank, the Orleans Parish School Board in May 1990,

Department of Education as a Blue Ribbon School of Excellence; and
WHEREAS, in May 2005, Edna Karr High School was honored again as a Blue
Ribbon School of Excellence; and
WHEREAS, Edna Karr High School is one of only a few schools nationwide to have
won the prestigious award twice; and
WHEREAS, in the aftermath of Hurricane Katrina, Edna Karr High School was one
of the first schools to reopen in the city of New Orleans; and
WHEREAS, as a part of the Algiers Charter Schools Association, Edna Karr
reopened as an open access college preparatory high school, accepting students from all over
Orleans Parish with an open admissions policy; and
WHEREAS, beginning in 2013, Edna Karr High School became a founding school
as part of InspireNOLA Charter Schools; and
WHEREAS, after over fifty years of service to the children of New Orleans, Edna
Karr High School continues to expand its reputation for excellence by attracting the best
students and teachers, continuing to provide quality education, and instilling in all the desire
to succeed.
