## **REVENUE EXPLANATION**

<u>Proposed law</u> will result in an increase in SGR as a result of increasing the maximum supervision fee payment by parolees from an amount not to exceed sixty-three dollars to an amount not to exceed one hundred dollars. The amount paid is based upon the parolees' ability to pay as determined by the committee on parole per R.S. 15.574(4)(2). The agency estimates that \$926,554 in additional self-generated revenue will be generated as a result of this legislation.
