CRIME/FELONIES RE SEE FISC NOTE GF EX See Note Prohibits the filing of a false lien against state officers and state employees

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<u>Proposed law</u> amends and reenacts portions of the law relative to the crime of filing a false lien. It also amends the crime of filing a false lien against a law enforcement officer or court officer to apply to state officers and state employees, provides for definitions, criminal penalties and related matters.

EXPENDITURE EXPLANATION

<u>Proposed law</u> may result in an indeterminable increase in SGF expenditures in the Department of Public Safety and Corrections – Corrections Services if a defendant is convicted of filing a false lien against a state officer or state employee. The maximum imprisonment term is two (2) years, with or without hard labor.

SGF expenditures will increase by \$51.90 per offender per day if an offender is housed in a state facility or \$24.39 for a state offender housed in a local facility. An offender sentenced to the custody of the Department of Public Safety and Corrections - Correction Services for one year would increase SGF expenditures by \$18,943.50 (\$51.90 per day x 365 days) if housed in a state facility and \$8,902.35 (\$24.39 per day x 365 days) if housed in a local facility. Approximately 50% of state offenders are housed in state facilities and approximately 50% of state offenders are housed in local facilities.

To the extent an offender serves the maximum imprisonment term of two (2) years, the cost in a state facility would be \$37,887 (1 offender x \$18,943.50 per year x 2 years) or \$17,804.70 (1 offender x \$8,902.35 per year x 2 years) if a state offender is housed in a local facility.

REVENUE EXPLANATION

The <u>proposed law</u> may result in an indeterminable increase in local funds revenue as result of potential fines. The maximum fine imposed for filing a false lien against a state officer or state employee is not less than \$500 <u>nor more than the amount of the value of the false lien or encumbrance</u>. The potential revenue will accrue to the local governing authority.
