A RESOLUTION

To commend Reid Didier upon attaining the rank of Eagle Scout of the Istrouma Area Council, Troop 888.

WHEREAS, the requirements for attaining the rank of Eagle Scout include: earning at least twenty-one merit badges; demonstrating Scout spirit, an ideal attitude based upon the Scout oath and law, service, and leadership; and an extensive service project that the Scout plans, organizes, leads, and manages; and

WHEREAS, Reid became a Cub Scout in 2010, and as a Webelos II Scout, earned the Religious Emblems Award, Parvuli Dei, a program developed by the National Catholic Committee on Scouting to help young scouts discover the presence of God in their daily lives and develop a positive self-image as they work with their families in the community; and

WHEREAS, as a First Class Scout, Reid earned the Year Round Camper Award for twelve consecutive months of camping, and demonstrating dedication and hard work on his way to this achievement; and

WHEREAS, during the past three years Reid has displayed reverence and patriotism by serving as a member of the honor guard at various local events, and has served as patrol leader, assistant senior patrol leader, and senior patrol leader during that time; and

WHEREAS, for the past seven years Reid has worked tirelessly on his journey to Eagle Scout, traveling to many states including Arkansas, Mississippi, Georgia, New Mexico, Florida, North Carolina, Tennessee, Virginia, and West Virginia for various

summer and winter camps, has earned the 50-Miler Award merit badge, and will attend the Philmont Scouting Camp in New Mexico in the summer of 2017; and

WHEREAS, Reid is presently an eighth grade student at Most Blessed Sacrament School in Baton Rouge, Louisiana, which he has attended since preschool and where he completed his Eagle Scout Service Project of rebuilding the flowerbeds on campus and building vegetable gardens for the kindergarten class; and

WHEREAS, Reid's extracurricular activities outside of scouting include playing basketball for Most Blessed Sacrament School since the third grade, playing in the summer basketball league for the YMCA for the past four years, attending basketball summer camps at St. Michael the Archangel High School in Baton Rouge, Louisiana, for the past five years, and recently playing the part of Simon Peter in the Passion Play at Most Blessed Sacrament School; and

WHEREAS, Reid will be attending St. Michael the Archangel High School in the fall of 2017, entering the freshman class with the goal of fostering St. Michael's mission as a disciple of Christ; and

WHEREAS, Reid desires to remain in scouting for the next four years so that he can serve as a role model, mentor, and leader for younger scouts; and

WHEREAS, at an Eagle Court of Honor held on May 6, 2017, Reid was awarded the rank of Eagle Scout of the Istrouma Area Council, Troop 888, the youngest Scout to attain this rank in his troop.

THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Senate of the Legislature of Louisiana does hereby commend Reid Didier upon attaining the rank of Eagle Scout of the Istrouma Area Council, Troop 888.
