EXPENDITURE EXPLANATION

The proposed legislation is anticipated to result in an indeterminable, but minimal, increase in SGF expenditures associated with travel reimbursements.

This bill establishes the Drug Policy Board's Advisory Council on Heroin and Opioid Prevention and Education. The council consists of 13 voting members and shall include a minimum of 13 nonvoting ex officio members. The council members shall not receive compensation or a per diem for their services or attendance at council meetings. However, the proposed legislation requires travel-related expenses be reimbursed by the council member's respective agency. The bill indicates that there shall be a minimum of 4 meetings per year. The current state milage reimbursement rate is \$0.59 per mile.

REVENUE EXPLANATION

There is no anticipated direct material effect on governmental revenues as a result of this measure.
