4	WHEREAS, the Ascension Episcopal School Blue Gators baseball team capped a
5	stellar overall 26-8 season by winning its first ever state championship at the 2017 Allstate
6	Sugar Bowl/LHSAA State Baseball Championship-Division IV by defeating Central
7	Catholic Morgan City by a score of 7-3 for the Blue Gators' first time ever beating the
8	Central Catholic Morgan City Eagles; and
9	WHEREAS, the path to the championship game went through a regional
10	championship over Hanson Memorial of Franklin by a score of 8-5, a quarterfinal shutout
11	win of 6-0 over Covenant Christian Academy of Houma, and a semifinal 3-0 shutout over
12	Houma Christian; and
13	WHEREAS, sophomore Carter Dooley was the starting pitcher for the championship
14	game, marking his first playoff appearance, where, after scattering five hits and two walks
15	through seven innings and salvaging a seventh inning bases-loaded jam to keep Central
16	Catholic scoreless for the inning, he ended up pitching all seven innings of the game limiting
17	the Eagles to only three runs; and
18	WHEREAS, pitcher Dooley was not the only Blue Gator standout in the
19	championship game with senior Jeffrey Elkins named Most Valuable Player of the game for
20	his three runs and one triple along with RBIs from sophomore Sean-Michael Brady who had
