I. SUMMARY OF JOINT RESOLUTION

This report is for House Bill No. <u>443</u> of the 2017 Regular Session by Representative <u>Stokes</u>, proposing to <u>amend Article VII</u>, <u>Section 10.17</u> of the Constitution.

HB 443 dedicates revenue to fund the inspector general's office.

II. CONCLUSION

The proposed measure can be accomplished statutorily.

HB 443 proposes to create the Inspector General Fund to provide for the dedication of sales tax revenue to fund the office of state inspector general. The Fund could be established by law, and therefore does not require a constitutional amendment. Other than to provide constitutional protection to the dedication of these funds, this measure could be accomplished statutorily.
