HOUSE RESOLUTION NO. 158

BY REPRESENTATIVE HOFFMANN

TEACHERS/EVALUATION: Requests the State Board of Elementary and Secondary Education to report information relative to the reliability of value-added data

1 A RESOLUTION

2 To urge and request the State Board of Elementary and Secondary Education to examine the
3 reliability of the data produced by the value-added assessment model used to
4 evaluate public school teachers and to include its findings and recommendations in
5 the annual report submitted to the House and Senate education committees as
6 required by law.

7 WHEREAS, Act No. 54 was enacted in the 2010 Regular Session and it required the
8 use of a value-added assessment model in the evaluation of public school teachers; and

9 WHEREAS, this Act further required the State Board of Elementary and Secondary
10 Education to submit a written report to the House Committee on Education and the Senate
11 Committee on Education by March first of each year regarding the implementation, results,
12 and effectiveness of the value-added assessment model; and

13 WHEREAS, a large number of Louisiana educators have expressed concerns about
14 the reliability of the data produced by the value-added model; and

15 WHEREAS, numerous research studies have been conducted in recent years
16 examining the reliability and effectiveness of value-added programs used in states and
17 school districts across the nation.

18 THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the House of Representatives of the
19 Legislature of Louisiana does hereby urge and request the State Board of Elementary and
20 Secondary Education to examine the reliability of the data collected by the state Department
21 of Education from the value-added assessment model used to evaluate public school teachers

1 and to include its findings and recommendations in the annual report submitted to the House
2 Committee on Education and the Senate Committee on Education by March 1, 2018, as
3 required in R.S. 17:3883(A)(8) for review, consideration, and discussion by the committees.

4 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that a copy of this Resolution be transmitted to the
5 president of the State Board of Elementary and Secondary Education and the state
6 superintendent of education.
