HIGHWAYS: Designates portions of certain Louisiana Highways

Synopsis of Senate Amendments	
1.	Makes technical changes.
2.	Requires the Dept. of Transportation and Development to erect and maintain appropriate signage provided the department receives local or private monies equal to their costs for material, fabrication, mounting, and installation of the signs, not to exceed \$550 per sign.

Digest of Bill as Finally Passed by Senate

Redesignates a portion of LA 118 that originates at U.S. Hwy. 171 and continues for 9.92 miles in Peason, LA, in Sabine Parish, as the "Joe Kirk Memorial Highway".

Provides that the redesignation in proposed law, which redesignates a portion of U.S. 118 as the "Joe Kirk Memorial Highway", will control and supersede present law (Acts 2011 R.S., No. 256), which designates a portion of U.S. Hwy. 118 as the "Louisiana Maneuvers and Purple Heart Memorial Highway".

Designates a portion of La. Hwy. 26 between mile marker 62 and 63 in Jefferson Davis Parish, as the "Michael Phillips Memorial Highway".

Designates a portion of La. Hwy. 102 between mile marker 26 and 27 in Jennings, La., as the "Burton "Burt" LeBlanc Memorial Highway".

Directs the Dept. of Transportation and Development to erect and maintain appropriate signage reflecting these highway designations, provided the department receives local or private monies equal to the department's actual costs of material, fabrication, mounting, and installation of the signs, not to exceed \$550 per sign.

Effective Aug. 1, 2017.
