DIGEST OF THE SENATE BILL AS RETURNED TO THE SENATE

SB 39 Reengrossed 2017 Regular Session Boudreaux

<u>Present law</u> provides that the governor appoint members of the Louisiana State Board of Medical Examiners when a vacancy occurs for any reason including expiration of term, removal, resignation, death, disability, or disqualification in the same manner as the original appointment.

<u>Present law</u> requires that members of the board be appointed for a term of four years, beginning on July first in the year in which the appointment is made, unless the member is appointed to fill an unfinished term of his predecessor.

Proposed law provides that no member shall serve more than three consecutive terms.

Effective upon signature of the governor or upon lapse of time for gubernatorial action.
