WHEREAS, Peter Douglas Broussard will be deeply missed by the church family where he and his wife served as youth group leaders who enjoyed taking their members to the African-American Youth Catholic Congress where he served tirelessly helping to rebuild the church after a devastating fire in 2010; and

WHEREAS, he leaves to mourn his passing, his loving wife of forty years, Carole Dugas Broussard; a daughter, Terri Renee Williams; a son, Brent Paul Broussard, and a sister, Joycelyn Artis, and a host of nieces, nephews, relatives, and dear friends; and WHEREAS, he was preceded in death by his parents, Doughty and Margaret Broussard; a sister, Nancy Broussard; and two brothers, Marshall and Kenneth Broussard; and

WHEREAS, he will be greatly missed by many who will always remember his daily words of wisdom and inspirational thoughts such as his favorite: "Without faith, we are nothing. Prayer is the door, so smile, open your eyes, love and go on with life".
