# RULE 6.8(A) REPORT OF THE HOUSE COMMITTEE ON CIVIL LAW AND PROCEDURE ON SENATE BILL NO. <u>61</u>

## I. SUMMARY OF JOINT RESOLUTION

This report is for Senate Bill No. <u>61</u> of the 2017 Regular Session by Senator <u>Allain</u>, proposing to <u>add Article VII, Section 21(N)</u> of the Constitution.

SB 61 authorizes local economic development authorities or districts to enter into contracts to exempt offshore vessels from ad valorem taxation.

#### **II. CONCLUSION**

The proposed measure cannot be accomplished statutorily.

SB 61 proposes to authorize local economic development authorities or districts to enter into contracts to exempt offshore vessels from ad valorem taxation. Any property to be exempted from add valorem taxes or the granting of authority to exempt property from taxes is required to be listed in the constitution, and a constitutional amendment is necessary to add such authority.
