#### HOUSE BILL NO. 323

#### BY REPRESENTATIVE FRANKLIN

1	AN ACT
2	To amend and reenact R.S. 4:732(A) through (E)(introductory paragraph) and (G) and
3	739(A)(1) and (2)(e) and (F) and to enact R.S. 4:707(J), 732(H) and (I), and
4	739(A)(2)(f), relative to charitable gaming; to authorize the conducting of
5	progressive mega jackpot bingo; to provide with respect to jackpots for progressive
6	bingo and progressive mega jackpot bingo games; to provide for exceptions to
7	amount of prizes awarded during a bingo session; to provide for applicability; to
8	provide relative to the net profit charitable organizations and distributors receive
9	from progressive bingo and progressive mega jackpot bingo games; to provide with
10	respect to Electronic Bingo Card Dabber Devices; to allow those devices to provide
11	for networking of charitable gaming organizations; to provide relative to the sales
12	of progressive mega jackpot bingo; to provide for player tracking; to provide relative
13	to regulatory authority; and to provide for related matters.
14	Be it enacted by the Legislature of Louisiana:
15	Section 1. R.S. 4:732(A) through (E)(introductory paragraph) and (G) and 739(A)(1)
16	and (2)(e) and (F) are hereby amended and reenacted and R.S. 4:707(J), 732(H) and (I), and
17	739(A)(2)(f) are hereby enacted to read as follows:
18	§707. Authorization to license certain organizations; exemption; requirement for
19	state license

1	J. The governing authority of a municipality or parish may, by ordinance,
2	transfer regulatory authority over charitable gaming in that municipality or parish to
3	the office of charitable gaming.
4	* * *
5	§732. Progressive bingo
6	A. Notwithstanding any provision of law to the contrary, the governing
7	authority of any parish or municipality may permit any charitable licensed
8	organization to conduct progressive <u>bingo or progressive</u> mega jackpot bingo games.
9	For the purpose of conducting a progressive bingo or progressive mega jackpot bingo
10	game, such organizations shall:
11	(1) Establish <u>electronic</u> links or networks, <del>electronic or otherwise,</del> <u>on an</u>
12	Electronic Bingo Card Dabber Device and related system or otherwise, between
13	locations, commercial or noncommercial, where licensed charitable bingo games are
14	being conducted.
15	(2) Deposit For a progressive bingo game, deposit a predetermined amount
16	of money not to exceed two hundred dollars per organization into a special account
17	before each licensed call bingo gaming session. Every two-hundred-dollar
18	contribution shall <u>not</u> constitute part of the total amount of prizes awarded during
19	that session.
20	(3) For progressive mega jackpot bingo, contributions deposited before each
21	gaming session shall not constitute part of the total amount of prizes awarded during
22	that session.
23	B. $(1)$ The mega jackpot for a progressive bingo game played pursuant to and
24	in accordance with the provisions of this Section may exceed the limit established
25	in R.S. 4:714, but shall not exceed one hundred thousand dollars, if the game is
26	played on bingo paper, bingo cards, or by using an Electronic Bingo Card Dabber
27	Device.

1	(2) The mega jackpot for a progressive mega jackpot bingo game played
2	pursuant to and in accordance with the provisions of this Section and networked or
3	linked together pursuant to Subsection G of this Section may exceed the limit
4	established in R.S. 4:714, but shall not exceed ten thousand dollars. Portions of
5	players' contributions to progressive mega jackpot bingo games may be used for
6	consolation prizes and to contribute to the progressive mega prize pool and shall not
7	be considered part of the limit established in R.S. 4:714(B).
8	C. Such game If required, such games shall be offered in accordance with
9	rules and regulations adopted by the governing authority of each municipality or the
10	parish which issued a license to any respective organization which participates in a
11	progressive mega jackpot bingo game, and in accordance with the rules and
12	regulations adopted by the office in Subsection D of this Section.
13	D. The office shall adopt rules and regulations governing progressive bingo
14	and progressive mega jackpot bingo games to insure ensure compliance with the
15	provisions of this Chapter and any additional regulations of the state relative to
16	charitable gaming laws.
17	E. Any licensed charitable organization or organizations playing at the same
18	location may conduct progressive blackout bingo games in accordance with rules
19	established and in effect on August 15, 1995, and as follows:
20	* * *
21	G. Organizations may network or link together, including through the use of
22	an Electronic Bingo Card Dabber Device to conduct progressive mega jackpot bingo
23	games, as provided in Paragraph $(A)(1)$ of this Section, provided the local governing
24	authority of each parish has authorized the conducting of such games in the parish.
25	H. Eighty percent of the net win from the progressive bingo and progressive
26	mega jackpot bingo games shall be paid to the charitable organization as defined in
27	R.S. 4:703(1). Twenty percent of the net win from the progressive bingo and
28	progressive mega jackpot bingo games shall be paid to the distributor as defined in
29	<u>R.S. 4:703(3).</u>

#### **ENROLLED**

1	I. Sales of progressive mega jackpot bingo on an Electronic Bingo Card
2	Dabber Device for any organization shall not exceed six games per hour and shall
3	not exceed the gross sales of bingo and pull-tabs in a single reporting quarter for any
4	organization. The office may suspend the sales of progressive mega jackpot bingo
5	for any organization that violates the provisions of this Subsection until the
6	organization becomes compliant.
7	* * *
8	§739. Use of electronic bingo card dabber devices
9	A.(1) Electronic bingo card dabber devices, hereafter referred to as
10	electronic dabber devices, and defined in Paragraph (2) of this Subsection, for the
11	public playing of bingo, progressive bingo, or progressive mega jackpot bingo may
12	be made available at any location licensed under the provisions of this Chapter
13	provided that all requirements of this Section and all requirements of this Chapter not
14	in conflict with this Section are met. Electronic bingo dabber devices shall not be
15	construed to be electronic video bingo machines or electronic pull-tab devices.
16	Electronic bingo dabber devices shall not offer for play the games authorized by the
17	provisions of R.S. 4:724 or R.S. 4:733.
18	(2) "Electronic Bingo Card Dabber Device", or "Electronic Dabber Device",
19	or "EBCDD" means an electronic device used by a bingo player to monitor bingo
20	cards purchased and electronically mark bingo cards downloaded into the device, at
21	the time and place of the licensed charitable bingo session, and which:
22	* * *
23	(e) Will not accept coins, currency, or tokens to activate play. Nothing in
24	this Paragraph shall prohibit the Electronic Bingo Card Dabber Device and related
25	systems from tracking a player's accounts and credits.
26	(f) Provide a means for all accounting functions related to bingo or
27	progressive or progressive mega bingo games.
28	* * *
29	F. The office shall adopt any additional rules and regulations necessary to
30	govern the specifications, use, and operation of electronic dabber devices and their

1	related systems, and shall establish a list of manufacturers, distributors, and suppliers
2	authorized to provide electronic dabber devices or a list of acceptable models of the
3	devices, acceptable serial numbers on such models, or manufacturers, distributors,
4	or suppliers.
