1 A RESOLUTION

2 To designate June 23 and 24, 2017, as the Class of 1962 Mighty Lions Days at the state
3 capitol.

4 WHEREAS, Capitol High School is the second oldest high school in East Baton
5 Rouge Parish and was built to educate African Americans; and

6 WHEREAS, in 1962, Capitol High School thrived under the faithful leadership of
7 Principal Charles W. Keel and many dedicated teachers; and

8 WHEREAS, Sterling Lands was the class president of the Class of 1962; and

9 WHEREAS, on May 30, 1962, high school diplomas were awarded to more than one
10 hundred ninety Capitol High School students who satisfactorily completed the high school
11 work required by the state; and

12 WHEREAS, as evidence of scholastic attainment and good character, a diploma was
13 awarded to students that day to signify their graduation from a state-approved Negro High
14 School of Louisiana; and

15 WHEREAS, on June 23 and 24, more than sixty members from the Class of 1962
16 will gather in Baton Rouge to celebrate and commemorate their fifty-fifth class reunion; and

17 WHEREAS, it is fitting to honor the members of the Capitol High School Class of
18 1962.

19 THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the House of Representatives of the
20 Legislature of Louisiana does hereby designate June 23 and 24, 2017, as the Class of 1962

- 1 Mighty Lions Days at the state capitol and does hereby congratulate the members of the
 - 2 Capitol High School Class of 1962 on the wonderful occasion of their reunion.
