<u>Proposed law</u> amends and reenacts R.S. 40:966(I) relative to the Uniform Controlled Dangerous Substances Law regarding the penalty for distribution or possession with intent to distribute narcotic drugs listed in Schedule I. <u>Proposed law</u> provides exemptions from arrest and prosecution under the Uniform Controlled Dangerous Substances Law to persons and other entities lawfully in possession of medical marijuana and provides for related matters.
