2	To amend and reenact R.S. 36:628(C)(1) and (E), relative to animal health and food safety
3	for commercial feeds; to provide clarification regarding the regulation of commercial
4	feeds; and to provide for related matters.
5	Be it enacted by the Legislature of Louisiana:
6	Section 1. R.S. 36:628(C)(1) and (E) are hereby amended and reenacted to read as
7	follows:
8	§628. Offices; purposes and functions
9	* * *
10	C.(1) The office of agricultural and environmental sciences shall administer
11	the provisions of law relating to fertilizers, seeds, plant diseases, commercial feeds,
12	pesticides, horticulture, and apiaries. The office shall perform technical services and
13	laboratory functions for the farmers of the state and shall perform functions designed
14	to expand and improve seed certification; increase production of rice and nursery
15	stock; monitor and provide for the prevention, control, and eradication of regulated
16	and exotic crop pests or diseases endangering Louisiana's agricultural, horticultural,
17	and apiary industries; assure that products certified for export are free from pests;
18	oversee the qualifications and practices of persons engaged in the green industry;
19	sample pesticides, feeds, fertilizer, seed, and agricultural materials to assure that they
20	meet all requirements of law and regulation; assure the proper labeling, distribution,
21	storage, sale, offering for sale, and application of pesticides; license and regulate
22	pesticide applicators and pest control companies; regulate the treatment, storage, and

1	disposal of pesticide wastes; and perform other related functions, all in accordance
2	with applicable law.
3	* * *
4	E. The office of animal health and food safety shall be responsible for the
5	inspection of meat, fruits, and vegetables, the control and eradication of infectious
6	diseases that affect the livestock and poultry industries of the state, the control of
7	livestock theft and denying a market for stolen cattle and horses in Louisiana, the
8	regulation of the manufacturing and sale of commercial feeds, and the enforcement
9	of Louisiana grown products and performance of other related functions, all in
10	accordance with applicable law.
