LaFleur

<u>Prior law</u> required the State Bd. of Elementary and Secondary Education (BESE) to provide for a statewide school and district accountability system.

<u>Prior law</u> required BESE to develop and implement a process to certify foreign language immersion programs.

New law, for a school that establishes, maintains, or expands a foreign language immersion program or proceeds to earn or maintain certification of a foreign language immersion program or that establishes, maintains, or expands any other program BESE deems appropriate, requires BESE to include a component in the school and district accountability system to annually award points to the school's annual performance score.

<u>New law</u> provides that the number of points awarded will be subject to approval by BESE and in accordance with federal law.

<u>New law</u> provides that BESE cannot prohibit a school from annually earning points in the school and district accountability system for maintaining a program that meets performance and quality standards established by the state board.

<u>New law</u> requires BESE to promulgate rules and regulations to implement the provisions of new law.

Effective upon signature of the governor (June 23, 2017).
