Jackson

Existing law provides for fees in civil matters to be paid to sheriffs as compensation.

New law retains existing law but increases the fees as follows:

- (1) Service and return of legal documents, notices, and subpoenas from \$20 to \$30.
- (2) Notice of seizure and sale and returns from \$20 to \$30 and return of any writ from \$20 to \$30.
- (3) Preparation for advertisement in newspapers from \$15 to \$30.
- (4) Execution for writ of possession or ejectment from \$20 to \$30.
- (5) Service of notice to vacate from \$20 to \$30.
- (6) Other actions to obtain possession of premises from \$20 to \$30.

New law makes these increases effective upon a recommendation by the Judicial Council in its 2018 report.
