Existing law authorizes the court reporter in the 27<sup>th</sup> JDC to charge and collect as compensation in addition to salary, a fee of \$3.50 per page for the original and 50¢ per page for copies reported and transcribed in all civil and criminal cases.

Existing law requires court reporters to be paid a fee of \$3.50 per 31-line page transcript and 50¢ per page for each copy to be paid from the criminal indigent transcript fund by the court.

<u>Prior law</u> (Act No. 194 of 2015 R.S.) provided that the increase in court reporter fees provided for under <u>existing law</u> are contingent upon and become effective if and when the Judicial Council reviews such request and makes a recommendation to the legislature in its 2016 report.

<u>New law</u> retains <u>existing law</u> but makes the court reporter fee increase effective upon a recommendation by the Judicial Council in its 2018 report.
