<u>Existing law</u> provides that the chairmen of the House Committee on Retirement and the Senate Committee on Retirement may authorize legislative staff to attend executive sessions of any board or committee meeting of a state or statewide retirement system. <u>Prior law</u> provided that the chairmen could authorize such attendance as ex officio members of the state and statewide retirement system boards. <u>New law</u> removes language specifying that this authority of the chairmen is exercised in their capacity as ex officio members of the state and statewide retirement system boards.

<u>Existing law</u> provides for elected, appointed, and ex officio members of the boards of trustees of the state and statewide retirement systems. <u>New law</u> prohibits a person who has been found in violation of the Code of Governmental Ethics for actions involving the misuse of public funds from serving as a trustee on any state or statewide retirement system board of trustees.

Effective August 1, 2017.
