**Abstract:** Provides for the effects of a misstatement or suppression of fact in an application for an alcoholic beverage permit or an accompanying affidavit.

<u>Present law</u>, regarding permits for dealers in beverages of low alcoholic content, provides that any misstatement or suppression of fact in an application or accompanying affidavit is a ground for the denial, withholding, or suspension of a permit.

<u>Proposed law</u> retains <u>present law</u> and makes it applicable to permits for dealers in high alcoholic content beverages. Further adds that a misstatement or suppression of fact may also result in the filing of criminal charges.
