Abstract: Authorizes the assistant secretary for the office of environmental compliance to delegate the authority to issue notices of violation or corrected notices of violation.

<u>Present law</u> authorizes the assistant secretary for the office of environmental compliance to issue a notice of violation or a compliance order within 10 days after the completion of the investigation that indicates a violation has occurred, is occurring, or is about to occur.

<u>Proposed law</u> retains <u>present law</u> and further allows the assistant secretary to delegate to a department administrator the authority to issue notices of violation and corrected notices of violation.

<u>Present law</u> requires any notice of violation to describe with reasonable specificity the nature of the violation and to advise the respondent of the consequences if compliance is not promptly achieved. Further requires the assistant secretary to notify the respondent of the issuance of the notice of violation or compliance order.

Proposed law retains present law.
