AN ACT

To repeal R.S. 33:423.24, relative to the city of Kaplan; to repeal authority of the elected chief of police to manage police personnel; and to provide for related matters.

Notice of intention to introduce this Act has been published.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of Louisiana:

Section 1. R.S. 33:423.24 is hereby repealed.

Present law provides as an exception that the elected chief of police in the city of Kaplan shall have the authority to appoint, promote, discipline, and dismiss police personnel subject to the budgetary limitations of the mayor and the board of aldermen pertaining to the number of allotted positions for the police department.

Proposed law repeals such authority.

Effective August 1, 2018.
