## DIGEST 2018 Regular Session

Carter

<u>Present law</u> provides that unlawful sales of weapons to minors is the selling or otherwise delivering for value of any firearm or other instrumentality customarily used as a dangerous weapon to any person under the age of 18.

<u>Proposed law</u> provides that unlawful sales of weapons to minors is the selling or otherwise delivering for value of any firearm or other instrumentality customarily used as a dangerous weapon to any person under the age of 21.

<u>Present law</u> provides that lack of knowledge of the minor's age shall not be a defense. <u>Proposed law</u> retains present law.

<u>Present law</u> provides that whoever commits the crime of unlawful sales of weapons to minors shall be fined not more than \$300 or imprisoned for not more than six months, or both.

<u>Proposed law</u> provides that whoever commits the crime of unlawful sales of weapons to minors shall be fined not more than \$1,000.00 or imprisoned for not more than 12 months, or both.
