HOUSE BILL NO. 205

PUBLIC BUILDINGS/GROUNDS: Authorizes the governing authority of the city of Kenner to name the Kenner police complex in honor of a living person

1 AN ACT

2 To enact R.S. 33:4712.19, relative to the naming of public buildings by the city of Kenner;
3 to authorize the governing authority of the city of Kenner to name the police
4 complex in honor of a living person; and to provide for related matters.

5 Notice of intention to introduce this Act has been published
6 as provided by Article III, Section 13 of the Constitution of
7 Louisiana.

8 Be it enacted by the Legislature of Louisiana:

9 Section 1. R.S. 33:4712.19 is hereby enacted to read as follows:

10 §4712.19. Naming of police complex; Kenner

11 Notwithstanding R.S. 42:267 or any other law to the contrary, the governing
12 authority of the city of Kenner may name the police complex in Kenner in honor of
13 Nick Congemi.

14 Section 2. This Act shall become effective upon signature by the governor or, if not
15 signed by the governor, upon expiration of the time for bills to become law without signature
16 by the governor, as provided by Article III, Section 18 of the Constitution of Louisiana. If
17 vetoed by the governor and subsequently approved by the legislature, this Act shall become
18 effective on the day following such approval.
