## DIGEST 2018 Regular Session

Perry

<u>Proposed law</u> authorizes the city of Scott, subject to voter approval, to levy an additional sales and use tax not to exceed 1%. Provides that the tax shall be in addition to all other authorized taxes and shall not be subject to rate limitations established by <u>present constitution</u> or <u>present law</u>. Further provides that the authority granted in <u>proposed law</u> shall not limit prior taxing authority granted to the city of Scott or any other political subdivision.

<u>Proposed law</u> further provides that the additional tax shall be collected at the same time and in the same manner as other sales and use taxes.

<u>Proposed law</u> further provides that two-thirds of the proceeds of the tax shall be used for emergency services provided by the fire and police departments and one-third of the proceeds shall be used for parks and recreations, cultural district, economic development, drainage, roads, and bridges.

<u>Proposed law</u> provides ballot proposition language.

Effective upon signature of governor or lapse of time for gubernatorial action.
