SB 200 Original

<u>Proposed law</u> provides that any contract to provide telephone services to inmates incarcerated at state or local correctional facilities:

- (1) Must be negotiated and awarded in a manner so as to provide for the lowest reasonable costs to both the person placing the call and the recipient of the call.
- (2) Must be negotiated and awarded in a manner so as to pay for any expenses of the Dept. of Public Safety and Corrections or other governing authority for establishing and administering any telephone contract.

<u>Proposed law</u> provides that all negotiations for procurement of inmate telephone services are to be in accordance with and subject to the requirements for telecommunications procurement under present law (La. Procurement Code).

<u>Proposed law</u> provides that any contract to provide inmate telephone services is subject to the bid requirements of <u>present law</u> and must be awarded to the lowest bidder.

<u>Proposed law</u> provides that any contract for inmate telephone services negotiated and awarded pursuant to <u>proposed law</u> cannot include any provision for profit by or commissions to the state or any governmental entity.
