Luneau

<u>Present law</u> provides for the unlawful transportation of diseased animals or livestock or adulterated meat.

<u>Present law</u> provides for a civil fine of \$5,000 for a first offense and a criminal penalty of not less than \$5,000 nor more than \$25,000, or imprisonment, with or without hard labor, for not less than one year nor more than 10 years, or both.

<u>Proposed law</u> retains <u>present law</u> and further authorizes all law enforcement agencies to enforce <u>present law</u> and rules adopted by the Bd. of Animal Health pursuant to <u>present law</u>.

Effective August 1, 2018.
