MTR VEHICLE/DRIVER LIC: Provides for a voluntary fee on driver's license applications to benefit the Military Family Assistance Fund

AN ACT

2 To amend and reenact R.S. 32:412(A)(1), (2), (5), (6), (B)(1), (2), (7)(e)(i)(aa), (dd)(I), 3 (ii)(aa), and (dd)(I) and R.S. 46:122(A)(1) and to enact R.S. 32:412(A)(8) and (B)(10), relative to driver's license fees; to provide for a one dollar increase in 4 5 driver's license fees applicable to certain driver's licenses; to provide for a voluntary 6 donation to the Louisiana Military Family Assistance Fund; and to provide for 7 related matters. 8 Be it enacted by the Legislature of Louisiana: 9 Section 1. R.S. 32:412(A)(1), (2), (5), (6), (B)(1), (2), (7)(e)(i)(aa), (dd)(I), (ii)(aa), 10 and (dd)(I) are hereby amended and reenacted and R.S. 32:412(A)(8) and (B)(10) are hereby 11 enacted to read as follows: 12 §412. Amount of fees; credit or refund; duration of license; veteran designation; 13 disabled veteran designation; university logo; "I'm a Cajun"designation; 14 disbursement of funds; renewal by mail or electronic commerce of Class "D" 15 or "E" drivers' licenses; disposition of certain fees; exception 16 A.(1) Every applicant for a Class "D" driver's license, or for a renewal of a 17 Class "D" driver's license, except those bona fide residents of the city of New Orleans, shall pay for such basic license a fee of forty-two forty-three dollars and 18 19 seventy-five cents. Eleven dollars and fifteen cents of the fee shall be paid to the

Louisiana State Police Retirement System Fund. One dollar and fifty cents of the fee shall be forwarded by the department to the litter abatement and education account which is created with the Conservation Fund through the provisions of R.S. 56:10(B)(15).

(2) The fee for Class "D" driver's licenses, or renewal of a Class "D" driver's license, issued to bona fide residents of the city of New Orleans shall be fifty-four fifty-five dollars, fifteen dollars of which shall be payable by the department to the board of trustees of the police pension fund of the city of New Orleans. One dollar and eighty-four cents of the fee shall be paid to the Louisiana State Police Retirement System Fund. One dollar and fifty cents of the fee shall be forwarded by the department to the litter abatement and education account which is created within the Conservation Fund through the provisions of R.S. 56:10(B)(15).

- (5) Every applicant for a Class "E" driver's license, or for a renewal of a Class "E" driver's license, except those bona fide residents of the city of New Orleans, shall pay for such basic license a fee of twenty twenty-one dollars and twenty-five cents, which shall be the cost of such basic license. Five dollars and sixty-three cents of the fee shall be paid to the Louisiana State Police Retirement System Fund. One dollar and fifty cents of the fee shall be forwarded by the department to the litter abatement and education account which is created within the Conservation Fund through the provisions of R.S. 56:10(B)(15).
- (6) The fee for a Class "E" driver's license, or renewal of a Class "E" driver's license, issued to bona fide residents of the city of New Orleans shall be twenty twenty-one dollars and twenty-five cents, three dollars and seventy-five cents of which fee shall be paid by the department to the board of trustees of the police pension funds of the city of New Orleans. Three dollars and seventy-five cents of the fee shall be paid to the Louisiana State Police Retirement System Fund. One dollar and fifty cents of the fee shall be forwarded by the department to the litter

seven dollars and seventy-five cents, which shall be the cost of the license. The license shall expire on the anniversary of the birthday of the applicant which is nearest to a date of six years subsequent to the issuing of the license, unless revoked, canceled, or suspended.

(dd)(I) Every applicant seventy years of age or older for a Class "D" driver's license, or for the renewal of a Class "D" driver's license, except those bona fide residents of the city of New Orleans, shall pay for such basic license a fee of twenty-two twenty-three dollars and thirteen cents, which shall be the cost of the license. The license shall expire on the anniversary of the birthday of the applicant which is nearest to the date of six years subsequent to the issuing issuance of the license, unless revoked, canceled, or suspended.

(ii)(aa) Every applicant seventy years of age or older for a Class "E" driver's license, or for the renewal of a Class "E" driver's license, issued to bona fide residents of the city of New Orleans, shall pay for such basic license a fee of six seven dollars and seventy-five cents, which shall be the cost of the license. This license shall expire on the anniversary of the birthday of the applicant which is nearest to a date of six years subsequent to the issuing issuance of the license, unless revoked, canceled, or suspended.

(dd)(I) Every applicant seventy years of age or older for a Class "D" driver's license, or for the renewal of a Class "D" driver's license, issued to bona fide residents of the city of New Orleans, shall pay for such basic license a fee of twenty-seven twenty-eight dollars and seventy-five cents, which shall be the cost of the license. This license shall expire on the anniversary of the birthday of the applicant which is nearest to the date of six years subsequent to the issuing issuance of the license, unless revoked, canceled, or suspended.

Abstract: Increases the driver's license fee applicable to Class "D" and "E" driver's licenses and Class "A", "B", and "C" commercial driver's licenses by one dollar. Allows an applicant to donate one dollar to the La. Military Family Assistance Fund.

<u>Present law</u> establishes a class "D" driver's license fee of \$42.75, except for residents of the city of New Orleans. <u>Present law</u> further provides for the distribution of the fee.

<u>Proposed law</u> increases the class "D" driver's license fee <u>from</u> \$42.75 <u>to</u> \$43.75, except for residents of the city of New Orleans.

<u>Present law</u> establishes a class "D" driver's license fee of \$54.00 for residents of the city of New Orleans. <u>Present law</u> further provides for the distribution of the fee.

<u>Proposed law</u> increases the class "D" driver's license fee $\underline{\text{from}}$ \$54.00 $\underline{\text{to}}$ \$55.00 for residents of the city of New Orleans.

<u>Present law</u> establishes a class "E" driver's license fee of \$20.25, except for residents of the city of New Orleans. Present law further provides for the distribution of the fee.

<u>Proposed law</u> increases the class "E" driver's license fee <u>from</u> \$20.25 <u>to</u> \$21.25, except for residents of the city of New Orleans.

<u>Present law</u> establishes a class "E" driver's license fee of \$20.25 for residents of the city of New Orleans. Present law further provides for the distribution of the fee.

<u>Proposed law</u> increases the class "E" driver's license fee <u>from</u> \$20.25 <u>to</u> \$21.25 for residents of the city of New Orleans.

<u>Present law</u> establishes a class "A", "B", or "C" commercial driver's license fee of \$61.50, except for residents of the city of New Orleans. <u>Present law</u> further provides for the distribution of the fee.

<u>Proposed law</u> increases the class "A", "B", or "C" commercial driver's license fee <u>from</u> \$61.50 to \$62.50, except for residents of the city of New Orleans.

<u>Present law</u> establishes a class "A", "B", or "C" commercial driver's license fee of \$76.50 for residents of the city of New Orleans. <u>Present law</u> further provides for the distribution of the fee.

<u>Proposed law</u> increases the class "A", "B", or "C" commercial driver's license fee <u>from</u> \$76.50 to \$77.50 for residents of the city of New Orleans.

<u>Present law</u> establishes for applicants 70 years or older a class "E" driver's license fee of \$6.75, except for residents of the city of New Orleans. <u>Present law</u> further provides for the distribution of the fee.

<u>Proposed law</u> increases the fee for applicants 70 years or older for a class "E" driver's license from \$6.75 to \$7.75, except for residents of the city of New Orleans.

<u>Present law</u> establishes for applicants 70 years or older a class "D" driver's license fee of \$22.13, except for residents of the city of New Orleans. <u>Present law</u> further provides for the distribution of the fee.

<u>Proposed law</u> increases the fee for applicants 70 years or older for a class "D" driver's license from \$22.13 to \$23.13, except for residents of the city of New Orleans.

<u>Present law</u> establishes for applicants 70 years or older, and a resident of the city of New Orleans, a class "E" driver's license fee of \$6.75. <u>Present law</u> further provides for the distribution of the fee.

<u>Proposed law</u> increases the fee for applicants 70 years or older, and a resident of the city of New Orleans, for a class "E" driver's license <u>from</u> \$6.75 <u>to</u> \$7.75.

<u>Present law</u> provides for applicants 70 years or older, and a resident of the city of New Orleans, a class "D" driver's license fee of \$27.75. <u>Present law</u> further provides for the distribution of the fee according to <u>present law</u>.

<u>Proposed law</u> increases the fee for applicants 70 years or older, and a resident of the city of New Orleans, for a class "D" driver's license <u>from</u> \$27.75 to \$28.75.

<u>Proposed law</u> allows an applicant to donate one dollar of the license fees provided for in <u>proposed law</u> to the La. Military Family Assistance Fund.

<u>Present law</u> provides for funds received pursuant to <u>present law</u> to be deposited in the La. Military Family Assistance Fund.

<u>Proposed law</u> adds the revenue derived from <u>proposed law</u> to the funds deposited in the La. Military Family Assistance Fund.
