Abstract: Provides relative to the reporting of threats of violence and terrorism at schools and requires mental health evaluations.

<u>Present law</u> does not require that teachers, principals, or other school employees report threats of violence or terrorism on school campuses to law enforcement.

<u>Present law</u> does not require any person who threatens violence or terrorism in a school setting to undergo a mental health evaluation.

Proposed law provides definitions for "school", "threat of violence", and "threat of terrorism".

<u>Proposed law</u> requires any school employee who learns of a threat of violence or terrorism at a school or a school-related function to report the threat to law enforcement.

<u>Proposed law</u> provides for procedures for law enforcement upon receiving a report of a threat of terrorism or violence on a school campus or school-related function.

<u>Proposed law</u> provides for mandatory mental health evaluations for individuals who make threats of violence or terrorism at schools or school-related functions.

<u>Proposed law</u> requires that any individual making a threat of violence or terrorism at a school or school-related function be prohibited from being within 500 feet of the school until undergoing a mental health evaluation and being cleared by a mental health professional to do so.
