INTERIOR DESIGNERS: Repeals relative to interior designers

1	AN ACT
2	To repeal Chapter 44 of Title 37 of the Louisiana Revised Statutes of 1950, comprised of
3	R.S. 37:3171 through 3186, relative to interior designers; to remove the State Board
4	of Examiners of Interior Designers; and to remove all regulatory, examination, and
5	registration provisions relative to interior designers.
6	Be it enacted by the Legislature of Louisiana:
7	Section 1. Chapter 44 of Title 37 of the Louisiana Revised Statutes of 1950,
8	comprised of R.S. 37:3171 through 3186, is hereby repealed in its entirety.
9	Section 2. Any rule or regulation promulgated by the State Board of Examiners of
10	Interior Designers providing for the regulation, examination, and licensing of interior
11	designers shall be null, void, and without effect upon the effective date of this Act. The
12	office of the governor shall issue a notice of intent to repeal such rules and regulations on
13	or before September 1, 2018 and adopt same on or before December 1, 2018.

<u>Present law</u> provides regulatory, examination, and registration provisions relative to interior designers.

<u>Proposed law</u> repeals the State Board of Examiners of Interior Designers and all regulatory provisions relative to interior designers.
