**Abstract:** Allows a district court to grant a hardship license for the fill period of suspension for driving while under intoxicated.

<u>Present law</u> provides that the department's requirement to suspend the license of any person 30 days upon a third violation, and 60 days upon fourth and any subsequent violation for littering cannot be construed as limiting or prohibiting a district court from granting a hardship or restricted driver's license for the full period of the suspension.

<u>Proposed law</u> modifies <u>present law</u> by applying the exception to first or second offence driving while intoxicated convictions.
