**Abstract:** Adds the crimes of domestic abuse battery, battery of a dating partner, false imprisonment while armed with a dangerous weapon, simple battery of persons with infirmities, and certain violations of protective orders to the list of enumerated crimes of violence.

<u>Present law</u> provides for a definition of "crime of violence" and provides for a list of forty-three enumerated present law offenses that are included as crimes of violence.

<u>Proposed law</u> retains <u>present law</u> and adds the following <u>present law</u> crimes to the list of enumerated crimes of violence:

- (1) Domestic abuse battery.
- (2) Battery of a dating partner.
- (3) False imprisonment while armed with a dangerous weapon.
- (4) Simple battery of persons with infirmities.
- (5) Violation of protective orders if the violation involves a battery or any crime of violence as defined by present law against the person for whose benefit the protective order is in effect.
