1 A RESOLUTION

2 To express the sincere condolences of the Senate of the Legislature of Louisiana upon the
3 death of Cecile Landry Daigle.

5 learned of the death of Cecile Landry Daigle on March 15, 2017, at the age of ninety; and

6 WHEREAS, Cecile Landry Daigle, born on January 16, 1927, to Drozin and Amelia
7 Guilbeau Landry in Broussard, Louisiana, was a lifelong resident of Lafayette and enjoyed
8 playing cards and bingo with her friends in Cankton; and

15 great-grandchildren, Ethan Brooks, Brayden Brooks, Eva Brooks, Aiden Landry, and
16 Elyse Johnson; one sister, Lucille Landry Sonnier; and several nieces and nephews; and

17 WHEREAS, she was preceded in death by her loving and devoted husband, Bennett
18 J. Daigle; her parents, Drozin and Amelia Guilbeau Landry; and four brothers, Phil Landry,

1 Alton Landry, Clarence Landry, and Lenis Landry; and

2 WHEREAS, she was a woman who was admired by all whose lives she touched and
3 will be greatly missed; and

4 WHEREAS, the death of Cecile Landry Daigle has left a substantial void in the
