- "Do you support an amendment to establish a state minimum wage which would require every employer with fifty or more employees to pay each employee eighteen years or older a minimum hourly wage of eight dollars beginning August 1, 2019, and eight dollars and fifty cents beginning August 1, 2020, adjusted annually for inflation, or the federal minimum wage, whichever is higher?"
