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**FUNDS/FUNDING** Prohibits the use of the Conservation Fund for any building acquisition unless the acquisition is approved by the Joint

Legislative Committee on the Budget

Proposed law prohibits the monies in the Conservation Fund from being used for building acquisition without prior approval of the Joint Legislative Committee on the Budget.

## **EXPENDITURE EXPLANATION**

Furthermore, the Department of Wildlife and Fisheries reports that it has not used Conservation Fund money for building acquisitions in the past.
