STUDENTS: Requires schools to provide information relative to influenza and immunization against the influenza virus

AN ACT

2 To enact R.S. 17:170.5 and 3996(B)(45), relative to immunization information for 3 elementary and secondary school students; to require schools to provide information 4 relative to influenza and immunization against the influenza virus to students' 5 parents; to require the state Department of Education to provide such information to 6 the parents of students enrolled in approved home study programs; to provide for 7 rules and regulations; and to provide for related matters. 8 Be it enacted by the Legislature of Louisiana: 9 Section 1. R.S. 17:170.5 and 3996(B)(45) are hereby enacted to read as follows: 10 §170.5. Immunization information; influenza 11 A.(1) Each public and nonpublic school governing authority shall provide 12 each student's parent or legal guardian with information relative to the risks 13 associated with influenza and the availability, effectiveness, and known 14 contraindications of immunization against the influenza virus. Such information 15 shall include the causes and symptoms of influenza, the means by which influenza 16 is spread, and the places where a parent or legal guardian may obtain additional 17 information and where a student may be immunized against the influenza virus. (2) The state Department of Education shall provide such information to the 18 19 parents of students enrolled in a home study program approved by the State Board 20 of Elementary and Secondary Education.

Abstract: Requires schools to provide up-to-date information about influenza and immunization against the influenza virus and the state Dept. of Education to provide such information to parents of students enrolled in approved home study programs.

Proposed law:

- (1) Requires the governing authority of each public school, including charter schools, and each nonpublic school to provide information about influenza and vaccination against the influenza virus and requires the state Dept. of Education (DOE) to provide such information to parents of students enrolled in approved home study programs.
- (2) Requires that this information include the causes, symptoms, and means by which influenza is spread and the places where parents and guardians may obtain additional information and vaccinations for their children.
- (3) Requires the La. Dept. of Health (LDH) to develop and provide information about influenza and the vaccination to DOE. LDH shall provide updates annually if new information on influenza is available. LDH, DOE, and each school governing authority shall determine the most cost-effective and efficient means of information distribution, including but not limited to posting on school websites and electronic distribution.
- (4) Requires LDH, in consultation with DOE, to establish rules for carrying out proposed law.
- (5) States that nothing in <u>proposed law</u> requires LDH, DOE, or any school governing authority to provide or purchase vaccines.

The Committee Amendments Proposed by <u>House Committee on Education</u> to the original bill:

- 1. Expand applicability of <u>proposed law</u> requirements to nonpublic schools.
- 2. Add requirement that state Dept. of Education provide information to parents of students enrolled in approved home study programs.
