<u>Present law</u> provides that no state of disaster or emergency may continue for longer than 30 days unless renewed by the governor.

Proposed law removes the present law 30-day requirement.

<u>Proposed law</u> allows the governor during a gubernatorially declared disaster or emergency to suspend liberative prescription and peremptive periods for all legal proceedings by executive order or proclamation, and to extend the period in which residents may file a claim against an insurer pursuant to R.S. 22:868 by executive order or proclamation.

Effective upon signature of the governor or lapse of time for gubernatorial action.
