SB 331 Reengrossed DIGEST
2018 Regular Session Colomb

Present law requires the issuance of a hang tag for a person with a permanent mobility impairment and upon a showing of good cause, renewable as any driver's license, for a period of four years and which remains valid until revoked or suspended.

Proposed law changes the renewal period from four years to ten years.

Present law authorizes any person with a permanent mobility impairment to obtain a hang tag or mobility impaired identification card at the issuance cost of \$3.00.

Proposed law changes the issuance cost from \$3.00 to \$7.50.

Effective August 1, 2018.

1. Changes the issuance cost of a permanent mobility impairment hang tag or impaired identification card from \$3.00 to \$7.50.
