14 The executive director secretary shall, with the consent of the governor, 15 appoint an undersecretary of management and finance as required in R.S. 36:306 and such assistants, as required in R.S. 36:308, and such heads of divisions 16 17 or bureaus, and such inspectors, statisticians, accountants, attorneys, and other employees as may be deemed necessary for the exercise of the powers and the 18 performance of the duties of the commission department. The executive director 19 20 secretary or a person designated by him shall develop a system of annual 21 performance evaluations for all officers and employees of the commission department based on measurable job tasks. The salaries of such officers and 22 23 employees of the commission department shall be fixed by the executive director secretary, with the approval of the governor. All officers and employees of the 24 25 commission department shall receive from the state their necessary and actual 26 expenses while traveling on the business of the commission department, either within or without the state." 27

- "\* \* \* 32 33 §306. Chief financial officer; functions; office of management and finance 34 A. There shall be a chief financial officer of the Louisiana Workforce 35 Commission Department of Labor, who shall be appointed by the governor with the consent of the Senate and who shall serve at the pleasure of the governor at a 36 37 salary fixed by the governor, which salary shall not exceed the amount approved for 38 such position by the legislature while in session. The chief financial officer shall be 39 the undersecretary of the office of Management and Finance of the Department

<u>of Labor and shall be</u> directly responsible to and shall perform his functions under the supervision and control of the executive director secretary.

B. The chief financial officer shall direct and be responsible for the functions of the office of management and finance within the Louisiana Workforce Commission Department of Labor. In such capacity he shall be responsible for accounting and budget control, procurement and contract management, management and program analysis, personnel management, and grants management for the commission department and all of its offices, including all agencies transferred to the Louisiana Workforce Commission Department of Labor, except as otherwise specifically provided in this Title. He shall employ, appoint, remove, assign, and promote such personnel as is necessary for the efficient administration of the office of management and finance and the performance of its powers, duties, functions, and responsibilities, in accordance with applicable civil service laws, rules, and regulations, and with policies and rules of the commission department, all subject to budgetary control and applicable laws. The chief financial officer shall exercise all powers and authority granted to him in this Title subject to the overall direction and control of the executive director secretary.

§308. Offices; purposes and functions

A. The purposes for which the offices of the Louisiana Workforce Commission Department of Labor are created shall be as set forth in this Section.

B. The office of workforce development shall perform the functions of the state relating to the administration, enforcement, supervision, and direction of programs related to the formulation of standards and policies promoting the welfare of wage-earning women; the employment of individuals with disabilities; vocational rehabilitation; independent living; blind services; customer service delivery; employment; training; minimum wage standards; welfare of workers and labor disputes, including the promotion of voluntary conciliation of disputes; regulation and certification of private employment agencies; minor labor laws; the formulation of policy relative to labor apprenticeship; worker protection programs, including medical payment; and employment security and employment service field services, all in accordance with applicable laws. <u>The secretary of the Department of Lobor, with the consent of the governor, shall appoint the assistant secretary of the office of workforce development.</u>

C. The office of unemployment insurance administration shall perform the functions of the state relating to the administration and enforcement of programs and services affecting unemployment compensation, all in accordance with applicable laws. <u>The secretary of Department of Labor, with the consent of the governor, shall appoint the assistant secretary of the office of unemployment insurance administration.</u>

D. The office of workers' compensation administration shall perform the functions of the state relating to the administration and enforcement of the law, rules, and regulations affecting workers' compensation. The secretary of the Department of Labor, with the consent of the governor, shall appoint the assistant secretary of the office of workers' compensation administration.

E. The office of occupational information services shall perform the functions
of the state relating to data processing and the development, analysis, and
dissemination of labor market and occupational information, including but not
limited to training and forecasting data. <u>The secretary of the Department of</u>
<u>Labor, with the consent of the governor, shall appoint the assistant secretary of</u>
the office of occupational information services."
