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LEGISLATIVE AUDITOR Authorizes the legislative Auditor to obtain certain information about employees with access to federal tax records of auditees. (8/1/18)

The present law provides the exclusive list of agencies that may have an agreement with the IRS to access federal tax information. The proposed legislation adds the Legislative Auditor to the agencies that can access federal tax information for purposes of performing audits. It further authorizes the Legislative Auditor to establish policies and procedures when performing criminal background checks on its current and prospective employees designated to audit the records of the Department of Revenue.
