HOUSE CONCURRENT RESOLUTION NO. 15

COLLEGES/SOUTHERN U: Requests that the Southern University Board of Supervisors submit a proposal to the Board of Regents for establishing an associate of applied science degree program in process technology and that the Board of Regents approve it

1 A CONCURRENT RESOLUTION 2 To urge and request the Board of Supervisors of Southern University and Agricultural and 3 Mechanical College to submit a proposal to the Board of Regents for the 4 establishment of an associate of applied science degree program in process 5 technology for students enrolled in Southern University at Shreveport, which would 6 be provided on the campus of Southern University at Baton Rouge through the 7 Southern University College Connect Program, and to urge and request the Board 8 of Regents to approve the proposal. 9 WHEREAS, an associate of applied science degree program in process technology, 10 commonly known as PTEC, is a program that trains students to become process technicians 11 who control and monitor the systems that run industrial plants; and 12 WHEREAS, an additional PTEC program offered at a postsecondary education 13 institution in the Baton Rouge region would help area students prepare to obtain high paying 14 jobs and would help to meet expanding workforce demands for process technicians in 15 industries including the chemical, oil and gas, and pharmaceutical industries; and 16 WHEREAS, there is great interest in establishing a PTEC program on the campus 17 of Southern University at Baton Rouge (SUBR); and 18 WHEREAS, Article VIII, Section 5 of the Constitution of Louisiana grants certain powers relating to public institutions of postsecondary education to the Board of Regents, 19 20 including the power to approve, disapprove, or modify a proposed degree program;

1 therefore, in order to establish an associate of applied science degree program in PTEC, the 2 Board of Supervisors of Southern University and Agricultural and Mechanical College must 3 seek and obtain the approval of the Board of Regents; and 4 WHEREAS, the Board of Regents has issued a moratorium on the consideration of 5 proposed associate degree programs at four-year institutions; and 6 WHEREAS, one avenue for the establishment of such a program on the campus of 7 SUBR, which is a four-year institution, is to provide this instruction through the Southern 8 University College Connect Program; and 9 WHEREAS, under this model, students would be admitted to and enroll in Southern 10 University at Shreveport (SUSLA), their home campus, but would receive instruction at 11 SUBR, their host campus; and 12 WHEREAS, a PTEC program for SUSLA students offered in Baton Rouge through 13 the Southern University College Connect Program would offer a rigorous study of various 14 process technologies and would prepare students to work in this growing and high demand 15 field; and 16 WHEREAS, in order to train students with the hands-on skills they need to enter the 17 workforce and to satisfy the hiring demands of Louisiana industries in plants, refineries, and 18 other industrial facilities, it is appropriate that an associate of applied science degree 19 program in process technology be established at Southern University at Shreveport and 20 provided at Southern University at Baton Rouge through the Southern University College 21 Connect Program. 22 THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Legislature of Louisiana does hereby 23 urge and request the Board of Supervisors of Southern University and Agricultural and 24 Mechanical College to submit a proposal to the Board of Regents for the approval of the 25 establishment of an associate of applied science degree program in process technology for 26 students enrolled in Southern University at Shreveport, which would be provided on the 27 campus of Southern University at Baton Rouge through the Southern University College 28 Connect Program. 29 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the legislature hereby urges and requests the 30 Board of Regents to approve the proposal.
