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| HB 778 Original | 2018 Regular Session | Jackson    |
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Abstract: Provides requirements for and restrictions relative to investigations of physicians by the La. State Board of Medical Examiners.

<u>Present law</u> provides that any staff member of the La. State Board of Medical Examiners, except the executive director, may be appointed to act as the lead investigator for any complaint regarding a physician received by the board or any investigation regarding a physician initiated by the board upon its own motion.

<u>Proposed law</u> retains the prohibition in <u>present law</u> on the executive director acting as lead investigator, and revises <u>present law</u> to require that the lead investigator be an attorney licensed to practice in La.

<u>Proposed law</u> stipulates that no physician shall be subject to an investigation by the board unless a complaint concerning the physician is received from a person other than an employee of the board or the board has adopted a motion which makes a finding that probable cause exists to conclude that a violation of any provision of <u>present law</u>, or any rule of the board promulgated pursuant to <u>present law</u>, has occurred.
